A PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM BETWEEN CROWN COLLEGE AND THE C&MA MID-AMERICA DISTRICT OFFICE

WHAT IS THE CROWN 30 PROGRAM?

The Crown 30 is a partnership between Crown College and the Mid-America Office of the Christian & Missionary Alliance (C&MA). The Crown 30 Program offers an opportunity for Alliance workers in pursuit of licensure to complete the needed coursework in biblical and theological studies. The Crown 30 Program is designed to be both convenient and affordable.

IS THIS PROGRAM A GOOD OPTION FOR ME?

The Crown 30 program provides undergraduate-level course content for students pursuing C&MA licensure or ordination. These professional development courses do not offer college credit but can be applied toward 30 credits of a Crown online or Omaha degree program. This is a good opportunity for students in the following scenarios:

- Little or no college credit earned to date

This program may not be best for the following scenarios:

- Has earned a Bachelor's Degree, and intends to pursue a Master's Degree.
- Has earned 60+ college credits and desire to finish a Bachelor's Degree. If you are in this scenario, contact our Admissions Team to have your college transcripts evaluated for transfer credit prior to beginning the Crown 30 Program.

We want to help you along the shortest and most cost-effective path to both your degree and your licensure.

WHEN CAN I BEGIN STUDYING UNDER THIS PROGRAM?

Students will have the opportunity to enter the Crown 30 Program at 6 points during the year—2 opportunities in the fall, 2 opportunities in the spring, and 2 opportunities in the summer.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE ME TO FINISH MY 30 CREDITS VIA THIS PROGRAM?

Students will complete 10 courses (30 credits) in under 2 years. Each course is 8 weeks long. Crown offers 2 modules per semester, Fall, Spring, & Summer totalling 6 modules each year. Students can take 1 course each module.

CAN I BALANCE THIS PROGRAM WITH FAMILY AND MINISTRY COMMITMENTS?

Any time a student pursues higher education, it's crucial for them to recognize that there is a level of commitment and sacrifice involved. Course studies require a commitment of time and energy over a sustained period. At Crown College, we recognize the busy schedules of our students, and we have worked diligently to build our courses into a convenient online format. Students in the Crown 30 Program, like our online and on-location programs, will complete just 1 class during each 8-week module. This provides students the opportunity to focus on only 1 class at a time, an easier schedule for many adult students who also honor commitments to their families, their employers and their churches.

WHAT IS THE COST TO COMPLETE THIS PROGRAM?

Tuition to complete the Crown 30 Program is \$3,600, plus the cost of textbooks. Textbooks average around \$50 per class, and students may purchase or rent their own textbooks.

Crown College offers our Old Testament and New Testament classes (3 credits each) online twice a year for free. By allowing Crown 30 students to complete these two classes as a part of the class rotation, students will complete those two classes free of charge.

Tuition for the other 24 credits is \$150/credit, (\$450/class) or \$3,600 total. This is a 66% savings over the tuition in our School of Online Studies & Graduate School.

Because this is a non-degree seeking program, no federal or institutional financial aid is available including loans, grants, Crown College scholarships, or tuition discounts. Your church or another external organization is welcome to provide a scholarship.

CAN I TRANSFER THESE CREDITS AND CONTINUE MY COLLEGE EDUCATION AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE CROWN 30 PROGRAM?

Yes! If you decide to continue in the pursuit of your Bachelor's Degree, Crown College will review your Crown 30 credits for application to your degree completion plan. If you intend to petition for your Crown 30 credits to apply to a Crown College degree program, you should save your coursework as you work through the Crown 30 Program. Our team will work with you to present your papers, projects, and notes.

Professional Development courses may apply toward Crown College online programs and on-location programs through Crown College Omaha. Credits will not transfer outside of Crown College.
